

# 2009 ENERGY TAX CREDIT ABC SEAMLESS QUALIFIED PRODUCT GUIDE

## WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW:

The new law increases the Code Sec. 25C residential energy property tax credits from 10% to 30%, raises the maximum cap to a **\$1,500** aggregate amount for 2009 and 2010 installations, eliminates the \$500 lifetime cap, and makes several other modifications.

- Installations on the eligible property must take place from Jan. 1, 2009 to Dec. 31, 2010.
- Not all **EnergyStar** labeled products will qualify for the credit.
- 30% of the cost of qualified materials (not labor) up to \$1500 can be credited.
- Maximum credit per homeowner for all improvements combined is \$1,500.
- A tax credit is an immediate deduction from tax liability, not a tax deduction or rebate.
- Pre-2008 credits are not counted toward the new \$1,500 maximum.
- These tax credits are not available on new homes.

## QUALIFIED PRODUCTS

### Insulation:

PACTIVE, GREEN GUARD, and PLYMOUTH FOAM insulation packages are 2009 IECC compliant and qualify for the 2009 ENERGY TAX CREDIT.

### ABC/ARROWLINE ROOFING:



ENERGY STAR rated roofing colors qualify for the Energy Tax Credit. Not all roofing colors are certified by Energy Star; the following ARE:

- Glacier White
- Cedar
- T-Tone
- Desert Tone
- Pewter
- Statuary Bronze
- Spruce Green
- Classic Red
- Sandtone
- Charcoal Gray (shake)
- Copper
- Bright Red

### ABC Windows:



The complete line of COMFORT and REASSURE windows qualify for the tax credit; including Double Hung, Double Slider, Single/Double/Triple Casement, Picture, Single/Double Awning style windows.

COMFORT line patio doors [6106]above Energy Saver (with Argon) also qualify.

REASSURE patio doors DO NOT qualify.

ASSURE windows are hit and miss and will need to be compared to the U-Factor and SHGC standards on a case-by-case basis.
